

ADRL TRANSITION FUNDING OVERVIEW

The Families First Coronavirus Response Act and Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act") provides for the provision of Transition Coordination Services, financial assistance for onetime moving costs, and rental assistance due to the COVID-19 pandemic. These services will be available until this funding has been exhausted.

The ND Centers for Independent Living will be providing these services on behalf of the ND Department of Human Services.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

Individuals with a disability of any age living in a provider operated residential situation that is transitioning back to a community residence that do not otherwise qualify for the MFP Grant or Community Transition Wavier services. (There are no income requirements for this program).

The residential situations can include nursing facilities, basic care facilities, assisted living facilities, homeless shelters, or other COVID-19 related group living environments.

SERVICES AVAILABLE

(Service will be provided by the local Center for Independent Living)

Transition Coordination Services

This service helps with planning and coordination of services for a successful return to community living.

Onetime Moving Costs

Payment of up to \$1,500 for return to community costs to enable successful return to community living.

Rent Assistance

Payment of monthly rent costs for individuals returning to the community for lengths of time to be approved on a case by case basis dependent on funding availability.
